Florida drug bill sparks unrest

When a Florida representative filed a bill aimed at regulating the rampant prescription drug abuse in his state, the reaction was anything but acceptance.

The bill is attempting to bar prescription drug dispensing except in pharmacies which "are part of publicly traded companies, have more than \$100 million in taxable assets or have been continuously permitted for 10 years." Another stipulation limits quantities of certain drugs shipped from wholesalers to each pharmacy.

Those involved in the fight against unfair regulation are claiming that the resources available as compared to insurance and physician groups are the equivalent to "slingshots" against their "cruise missiles."
